THANK YOU: Carl Schueler, Senior Planner, City of Colorado Springs Land Use Review Division, for the informative update during our March meeting on the *Academy Blvd. Corridor Great Streets Plan*.

PROGRAM: There have been a number of calls and e-mails about what the city will or will not do if there is a breakage in a homeowner's sewer line. Kristin Flannery, Business Affairs & Issues Management, Springs Utilities, will speak to our members to clear up any misunderstandings. If you have a question or concerns about a potential future problem, this is your opportunity to get direct answers. District 5 State Representative Mark Wallace also will address our meeting, covering laws that have been passed during the 2011 assembly. It is always interesting to learn how our tax money is being spent – come and find out.

CSPD SAND CREEK POLICE DIVISION / CALLS FOR SERVICE: Historically we have reported total and type of calls for service in our neighborhood in our newsletter, but it may be more useful to know WHERE the problems are occurring, rather than just what and how many. We have another source to offer that may be more informative. There is a website that gives information on calls for service. It lists the addresses and the reason for the calls. Check out www.springsgov.com and click on coloradosprings.com.publicsafety. The site you want is www.myneighborhoodupdate.net. You can enter the name of the street you are interested in, and the calls for service will be listed. Without internet access, call Nancy at 597-1174; will try to help you get the desired information.

LIGHTS AND LOCKS FOR SENIORS: A program funded by the Federal Community Block Grant Program helps low income seniors improve security of their homes. If you are 55 or older and the property is your primary residence, whether you are the homeowner or a tenant, you may qualify for some assistance through the program if your gross income falls within certain limits. SKUNKS: Since April 18, 2011 there have been reports of five rabid skunks in El Paso county – one near Powers Blvd. & N. Carefree Cir. To prevent rabies, it is essential to have your pets – dogs & cats – vaccinated. Don't harbor or feed wild animals and don't keep food or pet food outside. If you see a skunk or other wildlife acting abnormally, especially during daylight hours (such as stumbling or having trouble walking, spinning in circles, acting aggressively...) promptly call the department of wildlife at (719) 277-5200 to report the animal's location. WEEDS: You are responsible for keeping the weeds and dry weeds in any utility easement behind your property cut below 9", as well as elsewhere on your property. One street in our neighborhood did a mass cooperative cleanout of the entire length of the easement on their street. Do this in your easement; be good neighbors and help clean it out.
